

# Disciple Notes

Week of September 16, 2024



In 1970, two scientists performed an experiment on young children, leaving them in a room for fifteen minutes with one marshmallow and promising that they would receive an additional treat if they didn't eat the first one. The scientists found that the kids did any number of things to avoid eating the first marshmallow. They talked and sang to themselves. They made up games and even tried to fall asleep in an

effort to distract themselves from the temptation to eat the marshmallow. In the end, two-thirds of the children couldn't wait and ate the candy!

It's hard to fight temptation even when we know that something better may be waiting on us. Even as adults, we struggle with resisting marshmallows and more. Just look at my half-empty peanut M&M jar! Unfortunately, the consequences for adults are often much more damaging. Our sin often spills over onto those closest to us.

Jesus faced temptation like us but He never gave in. How did He do it? We're going to take a look at that and more this week as we talk about Luke 4. I hope you'll join us as we continue our new sermon series called *"Seeker. Savior."* from Luke 19:10) as we walk through the Gospel of Luke. You can prepare for Sunday by reading Luke 4 as Jesus overcomes temptation in the wilderness and then faces rejection in his hometown.
