The fall

Adam and Eve sinned, and paradise was lost.

God's present wrath

God reveals Himself through creation. Romans 1:18-20

- God's natural revelation is available to all people.
- We're held responsible by God because He has revealed Himself through His creation.
- We have no excuse to not seek out our creator.

Rebellious man chooses to suppress the truth about God and will experience God's wrath.

- o Romans 1:18
- God's wrath is His controlled and just response to sin.
 - Hebrews 10:27
 - Hebrews 10:31
- God's wrath is poured out <u>now</u> and in the <u>future</u>.

Rebellious man refuses to glorify or thank God.

- o Romans 1:21-22
- Those who rebel have foolish thinking and hardened hearts.
 - o Ephesians 4:18-19

We're all worshipers, created to worship and glorify God.

- Rebellious man chooses to worship idols instead of God.
 - o Romans 1:23
- An idol is anything we choose to disobey God over because we want it more than we want God. – Tim Keller

- God's present wrath gives us over to our sin and all of its <u>consequences.Rom.1:24</u> What are some of your consequences?
- God gives sinful man over to degrading sexual impurity.
- God designed sex to be enjoyed by a man and woman in marriage. List His Garden of Eden design:

Rebellious man exchanges God's truth for a lie.

- All sexual sin is <u>equally</u> sin in God's eyes.
- Sexual sin is damaging.

Rebellious man's mind is depraved because he refused the knowledge of God.

Romans 1:18-32

¹⁸ For God's [holy] wrath *and* indignation are revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who in their wickedness repress *and* hinder the truth *and* make it inoperative. ¹⁹ For that which is known about God is evident to them *and* made plain in their inner consciousness, because God [Himself] has shown it to them. ²⁰ For ever since the creation of the

world His invisible nature and attributes, that is, His eternal power and divinity, have been made intelligible and clearly discernible in and through the things that have been made (His handiworks). So [men] are without excuse [altogether without any defense or justification],²¹ Because when they knew and recognized Him as God, they did not honor and glorify Him as God or give Him thanks. But instead they became futile and agodless in their thinking [with vain imaginings, foolish reasoning, and stupid speculations] and their senseless minds were darkened.²² Claiming to be wise, they became fools [professing to be smart, they made simpletons of themselves]. 23 And by them the glory and majesty and excellence of the immortal God were exchanged for and represented by images, resembling mortal man and birds and beasts and reptiles.²⁴ Therefore *God gave them* <u>up</u> in the lusts of their [own] hearts to sexual impurity, to the dishonoring of their bodies among themselves [abandoning them to the degrading power of sin], 25 Because they exchanged the truth of God for a lie and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, Who is blessed forever! Amen (so be it).²⁶ For this reason *God gave them over and* abandoned them to vile affections and degrading passions. For their women exchanged their natural function for an unnatural and abnormal one,²⁷ And the men also turned from natural relations with women and were set ablaze (burning out, consumed) with lust for one another—men committing shameful acts with men and suffering in their own bodies and personalities the inevitable consequences and penalty of their wrong-doing and going astray, which was [their] fitting retribution.²⁸ And so, since they did not see fit to acknowledge God or approve of Him or consider Him worth the knowing, *God gave them over* to abase *and* condemned mind to do things not proper or decent but loathsome, ²⁹ Until they were filled (permeated and saturated) with every kind of unrighteousness, iniquity, grasping and covetous greed, and malice. [They were] full of envy and jealousy, murder, strife, deceit and treachery, ill will and cruel ways. [They were] secret backbiters and gossipers, 30 Slanderers, hateful to and hating God,

full of insolence, arrogance, [and] boasting; inventors of new forms of evil, disobedient *and* undutiful to parents.³¹ [They were] without understanding, conscienceless *and* faithless, heartless *and* loveless [and] merciless.³² Though they are fully aware of God's righteous decree that those who do such things deserve to die, they not only do them themselves but approve *and* applaud others who practice them.

I Cor.6: 15-20⁵ Do you not see and know that your bodies are members (bodily parts) of Christ (the Messiah)? Am I therefore to take the parts of Christ and make [them] parts of a prostitute? Never! Never! 16 Or do you not know and realize that when a man joins himself to a prostitute, he becomes one body with her? The two, it is written, shall become one flesh. 17 But the person who is united to the Lord becomes one spirit with Him. 18 Shun immorality and all sexual looseness [flee from impurity in thought, word, or deed]. Any other sin which a man commits is one outside the body, but he who commits sexual immorality sins against his own body. 19 Do you not know that your body is the temple (the very sanctuary) of the Holy Spirit Who lives within you, Whom you have received [as a Gift] from God? You are not your own,²⁰ You were bought with a price [purchased with a @preciousness and paid for, @made His own]. So then, honor God and bring glory to Him in your body.

1Cor 6:11¹¹ And such some of you were [once]. But you were washed clean (purified by a complete atonement for sin and made free from the guilt of sin), and you were consecrated (set apart, hallowed), and you were justified [pronounced righteous, by trusting] in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and in the [Holy] Spirit of our God.

Isa 53:4Surely He has borne our griefs (sicknesses, weaknesses, and distresses) and carried our sorrows *and* pains [of punishment], yet we [ignorantly] considered Him stricken, smitten, and afflicted by God [as if with leprosy]
